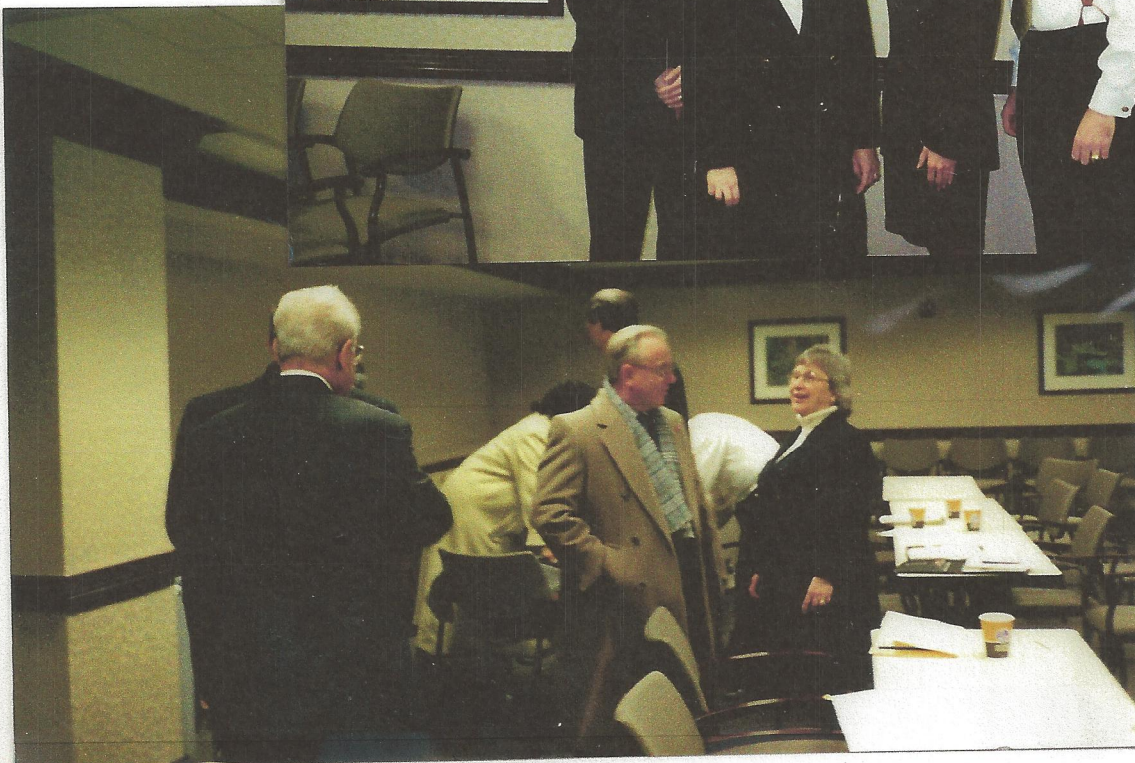

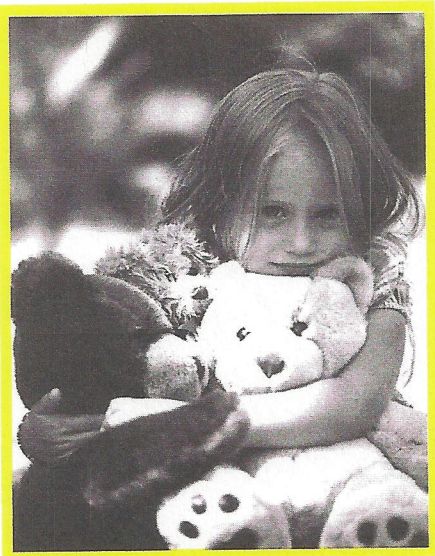

**New Home**

Prevention Education Inc.’s new home, located at 231 Lawrence Road, will contain 7,200 square feet on one level and parking for 30 cars. Presently, 2,318 square feet of space in the new building is rented. Thus, **Prevention Education Inc.** will initially have access to almost twice its current space.

- Our new home will enable us to provide children who have been traumatized by sexual abuse with “child friendly” and “age-appropriate” space for their counseling sessions.
- We will have appropriate private space available to conduct interviews and/or to have a confidential telephone conversation with a client family.
- There will be additional private counseling space; a large room for visitations involving larger families; a second visitation room; an enlarged waiting area; and a room to conduct staff training and seminars.
- We will be able to offer new and expanded services and programs in the future for children and their families. No longer will the constrains of space prevent the agency from seizing new programmatic opportunities.

The cost of acquiring, renovating and outfitting the new property is \$680,000. The agency has been able to secure very favorable low-interest financing for the project from the Community Loan Fund of New Jersey (\$150,000 five-year balloon loan at 8%) and the New Jersey Economic Development Authority (\$250,000 twenty-five year loan at 5%). Additional financing is being provided by Commerce Bank.



## Sponsorship Opportunities

The following project sponsorship opportunities are available:

- \$50,000 donation will ensure its donor an engraved plaque at the main entrance to the building.
- \$25,000 donation will ensure its donor an engraved plaque in the waiting area and/or conference room.
- \$15,000 donation will ensure its donor an engraved plaque at the entrance of a visitation room.
- \$10,000 donation will ensure its donor an engraved plaque at the entrance of a counseling room.
