PEI Kids is looking for a high energy, well rounded individuals for our Supervised Visitation Program to facilitate visits between children in foster care and their biological parents and/or siblings. If you have great life skills, are able to adapt to flexible situations and hours, are great with children and have a good rapport with people, this will be a wonderful job opportunity for you.

Primary responsibilities include:

- Provide supervised visits for children in foster care and their biological parents and/or siblings. Visits take place at different locations, including the PEI Kids office.
- Write observational reports of each visit, that are submitted to the Department of Child Protection and Permanency
- Transport children and/or their parents to and from visits. PEI Kids supplies car and gas.
- Work as a team member with the Support Services Director, Coordinator, Visitors and drivers.

Essential Job requirements:

- Experience working with children ages infant – older teens and their families
- A high school diploma and some post secondary training or college.
- Demonstrate good writing and grammar skills.
- Ability to move in and out of cars, carry up to 35 pounds and assist children in and out of cars.
- Basic computer skills including Word
- Ability to work up to 10 hours per week. Work week schedules change and may include mornings, late afternoons, some evenings and Saturdays.
- A clean driving record and must pass a thorough background check.
